

Subject: Submission of UCs/ Audit Report under Annapurna Scheme.

Dear Shri Vikram Dev Dutt,

I am writing this letter to draw your kind attention for initiatives taken by your Government regarding implementation of Annapurna scheme under NSAP.

As you are aware, under the Annapurna scheme, 10 kgs of foodgrains (wheat or rice) is given per month per beneficiaries. The scheme is aimed at providing food security to meet the requirement of those old aged persons who had remained uncovered under the Indira Gandhi National Old Age Pension Scheme (IGNOAPS) of Government of India. It is noted that your State is not availing the provisions under the Scheme during the past two to three years, perhaps, due to the innovative provision of the State, whereby the left out under IGNOAPS are suitably compensated by the respective State/UT administration under its own scheme. If that be so a line in confirmation will be highly appreciated.

However, in case any such beneficiary is left out, I would like to request you to kindly advise the concerned official to undertake a fresh exercise to identify such beneficiaries and furnish the suitable documents under the scheme so that necessary food grains is got released from Central Government.

I would like to request you to kindly direct the concerned Department to submit the suitable UCs and other reports, so that the pending due can be processed at our end early.
