Dear

As you are aware that the National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP) is striving towards achieving complete DBT compliance. For this purpose, four out of five schemes of NSAP i.e. IGNOAPS, IGWPS, IGNDPS and NFBS are now on-boarded DBT platform wherein reporting of status of DBT transactions will occur from NSAP-PPS to DBT Bharat portal directly through web services on a monthly basis. The accuracy of the monthly reports depends entirely on monthly disbursement of pension and regular and timely reporting of monthly DBT transactions by States/UTs on NSAP-PPS.

2. In this regard, I would like to apprise you that NSAP scheme has been assigned a target of 22 Crore DBT transactions during F.Y. 2018-19 and with the efforts of the States/UTs, the number of total digital transactions during 2017-18 under NSAP reached to 15 Crores, recorded a quantum jump of 767% over the total digital transactions of 1.76 Crore during 2016-17. This became possible due to the contribution of only a few States. It is estimated that the number of digital transactions can be further increased and doubled when all States/UTs embrace DBT as the preferred mode of pension disbursement under NSAP. In order to achieve the target of DBT transactions assigned to NSAP for F.Y.2018-19, the targets have been further distributed among States/UTs, as conveyed in Annexure enclosed herewith.
3. In view of the above, you are requested to ensure that the data pertaining to DBT transactions i.r.o. your State is reported positively by 8th day of every month on www.nsap.nic.in either through web services or by sending the data to Central NSAP team for uploading at so-nsap@hotmail.com and mis-nsap@nic.in. As mentioned above, NSAP-PPS has now been integrated with DBT Bharat portal wherein the DBT transactions report for a given month is synced on 10th day of the next month. Therefore, monthly reporting of DBT transactions by the 8th of every month is mandatory. It is pertinent to mention that if transaction data is not reported by the given date, it cannot be reported further to DBT Bharat portal during the entire F.Y. resulting in under-reporting for your State.
4. Accordingly, timely and monthly disbursement of pension to the NSAP beneficiaries is mandatory in order for States to be able to report monthly DBT transactions. The integration of NSAP-PPS with DBT Bharat portal has enabled Centralized monitoring by Prime Minister's Office (PMO) of monthly pension disbursement in States.
